Imagination becomes reality at Kilauea Military Camp (KMC) on the Big Island of Hawaii.

And lest you think being on an active volcano means any kind of danger, KMC has been around since the turn of the century, safely! Visitors quickly learn that the kind of volcanos we have in Hawaii are "effusive" or non-explosive.

Guests at KMC range from single Sailors (some with buddies or family members they bring along), to couples and families to retirees.

All enjoy private cabins or apartments with fireplaces tucked against the flora and fauna found at this elevation. Thanks to Seabee skill and ingenuity,

the cabins are modern and comfortable with amenities including in-room coffee, cable TV, fire logs delivered and plenty of comfortable sleeping space.

Settling in at KMC brings perspective of activities and options that makes you wish you could stay longer. The tours provided run every day except Sunday and bring you vistas like crater rims, live lava flows if they're happening and ancient Hawaiian petroglyphs accompa-

nied by knowledgeable and friendly tour guides.

KMC tours will take you all around the island so you can explore what makes the Big Island unique, from lush cattle country and beautiful unsurpassed waterfalls to coast lines starkly contrasted with lava flows that cause the viewer to look twice.

KMC vans will pick you up at the airport and you can spend your entire vis-

it without having to rent a car. Activities at the camp itself include hikes that range from a simple less-than-a-mile walk to multiple day hikes. You can enjoy the bowling alley, let the kids enjoy the outdoor play area or choose to use the recreational center's facilities.


Meals at KMC are a terrific value. Breakfasts, lunches and dinners are all
